

62nd Hong Kong Schools Music Festival Arrival Time and Admission Arrangement

As the pandemic influenza continues, the Association has to reduce the number of competitors and teachers/parents gathering at a competition venue at one time to minimise the spread of the disease. Competitors should arrive at the competition venue only 15 minutes before their own “competition time” published in the Festival Timetable.

Competition time for the following competitors is 9:30 am -

As shown in the above sample competitor list, it is a competition in which the competitors are divided into two Batches. The “competition time” of Batch One is 9:30 am while the “competition time” of Batch Two is 10:45 am. Take Competitors W, X, Y and Z as an example, their “competition time” is 10:45 am. Therefore, there is no need for them to arrive at 9:30 am. They should only arrive and report to the competition assistant at 10:30 am instead.

Competitors of Batch One (i.e. 1-30 in the example) and their accompanying adults must leave the venue when Batch One finishes. They may return for the result and their mark sheets when Batch Two finishes. Competitors of Batch Two (i.e. 31-55 in the example) and their accompanying adults will not be admitted to the competition venue before the “competition time” of Batch Two.
