Prize-winners' Recitals of the 70th Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival

The 70th Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival closes with a grand finale, the Prize-winners' Recitals, in January 2019. More than 170,000 students participated in the 70th Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival, and they demonstrated a high level of performance in Chinese and English speech. To enable students to learn from one another and to promote the speech appreciation in the community, two recitals of different programmes will be organised at 2:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. at the Y Theatre of Youth Square on 26 January 2019 (Saturday) by the Hong Kong Schools Music and Speech Association.

The recitals are given by outstanding prize-winners recommended by the adjudicators, including the Hong Kong representative of the International Public Speaking Competition in London (May 2019). The programmes cover English, Cantonese and Putonghua classes of the Speech Festival including solo speaking, choral speaking, public speaking, duologue, and Shakespeare's monologue, etc. With the special designed programmes, the audience will see the charm of the recitation art.
